**7 events • 1 ball • 66 volunteers • 141 hours of service**



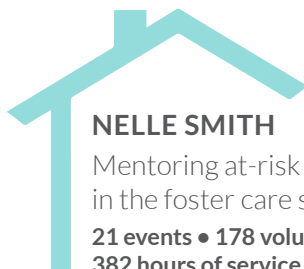
